SCOG REPORT NOV 2025

Following last year's AGM the Standing Committee on Governance (SCOG) has continued its work and in June 2025 published its report on the makeup and structure of the Club Rugby Board (CRB).

In that report SCOG set out five different models or options for the CRB ranging from the retention of the status quo through to a very streamlined executive style board.

Whilst SCOG favours a more regional based model as identified in the report any significant change will require approval from the member clubs.

It has therefore been agreed with the CRB and SRU Boards that a separate sub-group made of representatives of the CRB, SCOG, Rugby Development, and the SRU Board be formed to discuss in detail the various options in order to ascertain which model best suits the demands of the modern club game in Scotland.

That sub-group has now met and will spend the next few months considering and consulting on the issues. This is with a view to reporting to the clubs in May 2026 so that any approved changes can hopefully be implemented prior to the start of season 2026/2027.
