Important Dates

Deadline for submission of abstracts: Monday 30 April 2018

Notification of acceptance date: Monday 21 May 2018

Please read and adhere to the following guidelines and instructions;

All abstracts should include:

- Author(s) name and affiliation
- Abstract title
- Please indicate relevant topic category
- Font: Arial Font Size: 12
- Word length: up to 500 words excluding references

Abstract Format

- Oral presentation
- Poster presentation

Abstract Preparation

The person submitting the abstract must accept full responsibility for submission of the abstract and ensure the presenting author(s) is responsible for the presentation of the abstract, whether as an oral and/or poster and attend the respective presentation session(s).

An email address will be requested for all authors and the notification email will be sent to these authors also.

There is no maximum number of authors allowed on an abstract.

Abstract titles should be a **maximum of 50 words** with no abbreviations. Abstract text should be **up to a maximum of 500 words** and no tables or figures should be inserted into the abstract title or text.

Abstracts will only be accepted if submitted via Ex Ordo Abstract Management System. You will be asked to create an account to enable you to submit an abstract.

Each seminar stream will have a maximum of 20 minutes to deliver their presentation.
